



Kentish Town Neighbourhood Development Plan **Adoption Statement**

In accordance with Regulation 20 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, this Statement hereby gives notice that on 19 September 2016 the London Borough of Camden made (adopted) the Kentish Town Neighbourhood Plan as a Development Plan Document for the designated neighbourhood area.

The Kentish Town Neighbourhood Area was formally designated on 10 April 2013.

This Statement confirms that the Kentish Town Neighbourhood Plan has legal effect as part of the Council's statutory Development Plan for the designated area. Development proposals located within the designated area will be determined therefore in accordance with the Development Plan (including the Kentish Town Neighbourhood Plan) unless material considerations indicate otherwise.
