If you wish to inspect the Statement of Accounts or any particular documents at our offices please apply first to statement_of_account@camden.gov.uk so that arrangements can be made.

Notice is given that a local government elector for the area of the Council, or his/her representative, may ask the auditor questions about the accounts as set out in Section 26 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act. Notice is given that from 3 June until 12 July any such elector may make objections to the auditor, under Section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014, relating to any matter where the auditor could take action under:

- under section 24 of the Local Authority and Accountability Act 2014: and
- under section 27 of the Local Authority and Accountability Act 2014 apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law

Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to me at the address given below.
