Area: Reparation

Project: Roundhouse

## You said:

- "Doing some recording in the studios myself and getting taught a bit more how to use the software."
- "Front Desk was least enjoyable, but I didn't mind it."
- "Doing more work in the studios."

**We did:** We now run Roundhouse inductions to help reparation kids find suitable roles, including studio support. Completing reparation grants free studio access for a year through Roundhouse membership, and we can fund a one-off £60 professional recording session for those interested in music.

## You said:

- "They should have let us ride the bikes. I think that would have been better after we'd worked on them."
- "Just more work on the bicycles each week."
- "More work on bicycles and getting your own bike at the end."
- "Expected to work on bicycles but worked on other things like carpentry."

**We did:** We're co-ordinating bike rides for reparation kids and promoting Avalon's dirt biking programme through their youth club. The Recycled flyer was updated to reflect Avalon's expansion into carpentry, engineering, and motorbike prep to manage expectation.

Project: Carpentry

## You said:

- "It was just the location that was just a bit weird. Everything was calm."
- "Difficult to find."

**We did:** We created a detailed directional video with how to find the project, as it is in an estate that can be hard to find. When a child is newly allocated to carpentry, we send the video to the child and parent/carer through WhatsApp or email to help with locating the project. This has proven to be helpful, as kids now access it easier.
