

E-bikes and Electric scooters use large lithium-ion

batteries which can present a risk or serious fire

or explosion in certain circumstances.

Follow these 5 steps when purchasing, charging and storing your electric scooter or e-bike to reduce fire risks:



Do your research: Only buy an e-bike, electric scooter, charger or battery from a known seller and check product reviews.

Read and follow the manufacturer's instructions for charging and using e-bikes and electric scooters.



Not all e-bikes and e-scooter batteries and chargers are compatible or safe when used together. Check and only use the manufacturers recommended battery and charger.



Always charge in a safe place without blocking exits, and always unplug your charger when you have finished charging. Fit smoke alarms in the area where you charge your batteries at home.

Never attempt to modify or tamper with your battery.
